

William Street Reserve upgrade



Bayside City Council is seeking feedback on a plan to upgrade William Street Reserve. The upgrade is part of Council's \$162 million four year plan to deliver on the priorities of the Bayside community including improving facilities for organised sport as well as informal recreation.



The upgrade plan includes

- 1 New sportsground lighting to allow sports players to train safely during weekday twilight and evenings
- 2 A new modern pavilion sited more centrally in the reserve including public toilets, female friendly change rooms and all abilities access
- 3 Renewed cricket nets
- 4 Renewed playground
 - Landscaping and tree planting
 - The dog off-leash status and existing basketball court will be retained as part of the upgrade.
